The Oyster Farming Fundamentals class has 25 openings. Priority will be given to five veterans and 10 commercial fishermen. If interest exceeds capacity, a lottery drawing will determine class entry. A random drawing of applicants, beginning with those who have demonstrated participation in the commercial seafood industry, will be conducted at the "Required Informational Session" on March 7, 2019. The first 25 will be offered positions in the Oyster Farming Fundamentals class, and the rank order will be used for selection of training gear type and farm plots after coursework completion.
