Ron Harmon sworn in as MCMR member

BILOXI, Miss. – Ron Harmon took the oath of office Tuesday and was sworn in as the newest member of the Mississippi Commission on Marine Resources.

Harmon, who lives in Gulfport, was appointed to the Commission by Gov. Phil Bryant and confirmed by the Mississippi Senate in March.

He will represent the charter boat industry on the MCMR.

Harmon has operated a charter boat business, Captain Ron's Charters, LLC, since 1989. He also supervises the marine unit for the Harrison County Sheriff's Office, a job he's held since 2008.

He and his wife, Pandy, have four daughters.

Harmon replaces Jimmy Taylor, whose term expired June 30, 2014.
