Oyster Council to hold public meetings March 16-18

BILOXI, Miss. – The Governor’s Oyster Council on Restoration and Resiliency will hold public meetings March 16-18 in each of the three coastal counties.

March 18: Gautier City Hall, 3330 U.S. 90, Gautier.

All meetings will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. There will be a presentation about the Oyster Council at the beginning of each meeting given by Jamie Miller, executive director of the Mississippi Department of Marine Resources. After that, the public will be able to make comments and suggestions.

The council’s recommendations will be put in a report that will be given to Gov. Phil Bryant in early June.
